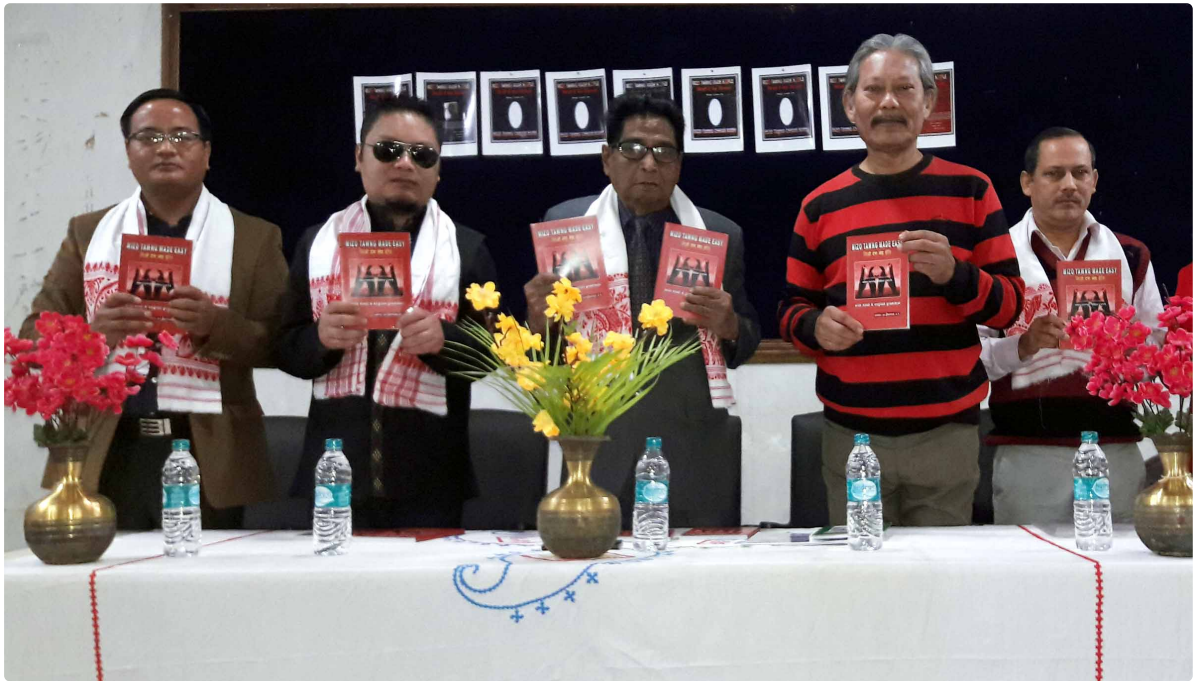


Mizo Tawng Made Easy released at press club
