

Modi assures aid to tide over flood



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Prime minister [Narendra Modi](#) has assured Assam all possible to help the [state](#) mitigate the misery in the time of flood [as](#) he reviewed the situation in Guwahati on Tuesday.

Flanked by governor Banwarilal Purohit, Assam [chief](#) minister Sarbananda Sonowal and his senior ministerial colleagues presented before Modi an audio visual presentation of the flood fury where 83 people were killed.

The government further sought a huge around Rs 30,000 crore fund to repair the ravaged [roads](#) and bridges apart from the measures to permanently resolve the perennial monsoon misery.
