Gujarat Chief Minister Narendra Modi on Monday strongly criticized his Assam counterpart for failing to efficiently deal with the law and order situation in the state.

In his address at a poll rally in Biswanath Chariali to campaign for RP Sarma, the prime ministerial candidate said that altogether 15 people were killed by the miscreants in Bihali. But Gogoi did not visited the bereaved the family members.

“Not only Gogoi, none of the Congress leaders were rushed to Bihar to convey sympathy to the people,” he said in his scathing attack on the chief minister.

“Why do you remember those who have forget you,” said Modi adding that those in power should be removed in the upcoming Lok Sabha polls.

Accompanied by senior party leaders including Sarbananda Sonowal and Bijoya Chakrabartty, Modi arrived in Biswanath Challiaali from Itanagar at 12-15 to be greeted by a huge gathering at the Kamala Kanta play ground.

Then he left for Gogamukh in Dhemajji district to campaign for Lakhimpur BJP candidate Sarbananda Sonowal at 2 in the afternoon.

Lok Sabha polls in this constituency will take place on April 7 along with Tezpur, Dibrugah, Lakhimpur and Koliabor.
