

Naga miscreants held



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Karbi Anglong police have arrested 5 miscreants from Nagaland when after they allegedly set on fire 7 houses on Friday night.

According to information, a group of miscreants from the neighbouring state arrived in a tiny village atop Rongapahar near Doldoli at night.

Apart from blank firing to unleash terror among the villagers, they set afire 7 houses forcing the police to step in.
