

Nagaland Cong chief resigns



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DIMAPUR: [Nagaland Congress](#) president Kewekhapse Therie has resigned owning moral responsibility for the party's poll debacle triggering a huge crises inside the grand old party in the north eastern [state](#).

Therie sent his resignation to the high command a couple of days after he himself faced defeat and his party failed to open an account in the assembly polls in a [state](#) where the party ruled for more than two decades.
