

Nagarik Samiti formed at Kalaigaon

A public meeting was held at Kalaigaon police station on July 22 to discuss ways and means to check social menaces like drug abuse, illegal trafficking of [girls](#) and woman, witch hunting, reckless driving etc and to help police department for maintenance of law and order and peace in the society. The meeting was organized by civil and police administration of [Bhergaon](#) sub-division at [VDP](#) Hall of Kalaigaon police station at 4 pm. Dimbeswar [Das](#), Officer-in-Charge, Kalaigaon PS in his introductory speech spoke on the need for cooperation between police and public.
