Nazira Girls' HS School Honours Meritorious Students at Academic Awards Ceremony

Awards instituted in memory of eminent personalities presented to outstanding students during Rabha Divas celebrations.

Jahnavi Budhagohain received the Jyotiprasad Bordoloi Memorial Encouragement Award.

Chadrika Akhtar Rahman was also awarded the Late Punya Prabha Devi Memorial Rolling Trophy, contributed by former students, and the Sujai Ahmed Memorial Rolling Trophy, instituted by Yasmin Kara Razzak, for securing the highest marks in the Higher Secondary examination in the school.
