

NDFB-S denies killing of Anup Basumatary

The Songbijit faction of the [National](#) Democratic Front of Boroland(NDFB-S) denied the killing of Anup Basumatary at Soraibil, Rangapara in Kokrajhar district.

Never bring the bloodshed again in our Bodoland for political gain, he appealed.

So, we strongly warn the Indian security forces not to [kill](#) our people and stay away from such barbaric activities. Thd outfit [leader](#) also request all the Boro people to stand united [against](#) the operation in BTAD, he added.
