

NDFB-S killed in Kokrajhar

A hardcore cadre to the NDFB-S was killed in an encounter with security forces at [Ultapani](#) area under Kokrajhar PS late last night in Kokrajhar district along the Indo Bhutan border.

Getting a tip top information about the presence of militant outfits in the area, a joint team of security forces from police, army and SSB conducted operation and encounter was held in between NDFB-S and forces where a hardcore cadre of the militant was killed on the spot.

The slain militant was identified as Bhusa Brahma@Bhuhum, a cadre of 38th batch of the outfit.

A pistol, three rounds and three hand grenades were recovered from his possession.

KOKRAJHAR, September 22, 2026 — The All Bodo Students' Union (ABSU) on Tuesday burnt copies of a book titled *Hamkoshar Parishista* during protests held at several locations across Assam, including Gauhati University, objecting to what it described as the use of the Assamese script to represent the Bodo language.

Hamkoshar Parishista is a multilingual appendix containing learning resources for indigenous languages of Assam, including Bodo, Rabha, Mising and Karbi.

During the protests, ABSU members alleged that Bodo has been represented in the publication using the Assamese script instead of Devanagari, the script used for Bodo.

The organisation asserted that Bodo is recognised under the Eighth Schedule of the Constitution of India and is an Associate Official Language of Assam. ABSU demanded that Bodo be represented in its recognised script in educational and learning resources.

ABSU president Khwrmmdao Wary said the use of the Assamese script to represent Bodo in the publication was disrespectful to the Bodo language and literature.

He said Bodo is an Associate Official Language of Assam and a language recognised under the Eighth Schedule of the Constitution.

Wary demanded the immediate withdrawal of the publication in its present form and called for the use of the Devanagari script for Bodo in the book.
