

NDFB-S on killing spree



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NDFB's anti-talk faction continues to unleash terror in BTAD areas. The Bodo militant outfit shot dead one more person in Chirang district on Saturday.

The attack took place at Panbari along the Indo-Bhutan border in the evening where four others persons have been injured. The injured have been undergoing treatment.

The incident took place hardly 24 hours after the militants massacred passengers from a Jonai bound bus from Siliguri in Kokrajhar. This is apart from the killing of a barber in Udalguri.

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
