

NDFB(S) slams chauvinist governments' for fake encounter

The Songbijit faction of the [National](#) Democratic Front of Boroland(NDFB) has come down heavily on Indian Army for the notorious killing innocent boys on Sunday at North Auzarguri under Serfanguri PS was reprehensible in Kokrajhar.

Having been condemning chauvinist governments' speeches and attritional policies we strongly denounce it [as](#) a total violation of Human Rights by the Indian Government herself and ask to keep aloof from such barbaric activities, he said.
