

NE film screening at Delhi from Aug 22

Films from northeast at the “Fragrances from the North East” will be screened at New Delhi on August 22-24. The [3](#)-days event is being organised by the Directorate of [Film](#) Festivals at Siri Fort Auditorium complex. Minister for Information & Broadcasting Prakash Javadekar will inaugurate the event which will be attended by several leading film personalities including Jahnu Barua, Aribam Syam Sharma, Danny Dengzongpa, Seema Biswas, Adil [Hussain](#), Geetanjali Thapa, etc.

The festival will begin with the screening of Mizo feature film “Khawnglung Run” (The Raid of Khawnglung) by Mapuia Chongthu. The festival also include two National [Award](#) winning films of this year: Jahnu Barua’s “Ajeyo” and Pradip Kurbah’s “Ri: A Homeland of Uncertainty” (Khasi, Meghalaya).

Representing Sikkim would be Prashant Rasaily's Gurkhali film "Katha", while [Manipur](#), Tripura and Arunachal Pradesh will be represented by Oinam Gautam [Singh](#)'s Manipuri language film "Phijigee Mani", Joseph Pulinthanath's Kokborok language film "Yarwng" and Ahsan Mujid's Monpa language film "Sonam" respectively.

Short film "Bamboo Shoots" by Steven Ao and a documentary "Going the Distance" directed by Tiainla Jamir will be screened - both from Nagaland.

The event will be supplemented by cultural programmes, handicraft exhibitions, food stalls.
