

NE students detained in Delhi



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Delhi police have detained at least 25 north eastern students when they staged dharna in Vijay Chowk demanding justice for the Nido Tania, who was killed by goons in Lajpurnagar.

The students, mostly, from Jawaharlal Nehru University suddenly staged blocked the road leading to the Rashtrapati Bhawan shouting slogans for justice to Nido Tania.

Despite appeal, police resorted to mild lathicharge to disperse the agitating students. At least 20 JNU students have been detained.

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
