

Need Toyota and not Dusters!



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KOHIMA: A couple of days after being forced to sit in the Opposition bench, a few NPF legislators in [Nagaland](#) has demanded end Toyota Innova Crysta to travel and not the Renault Dusters that fail to comfort them.

A [group](#) of nearly one dozen NPF legislators has written to the assembly secretary raising the demand refusing to accept the Rs 13 lakh vehicles after all they want Rs. 22 lakh Toyota Innova Crysta.
