

Netaji did not die a hard death: Dev chaudhory



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Freedom fighter and one time close aide of Netaji, Umesh Chandra Devchaudhory on Wednesday demanded that the Mukherjee Commission report should be made public to unearth the circumstances leading to the death of Subhas Chandra Bose.

Remembering Netaji on his 112th birth anniversary, Mr Devchaudhory said that the leader was killed during the Nehru regime. Quoting an Ananda Bazaar Patrika story, he observed that Netaji did not had a natural death and was killed.
