

New party emerges in BTAD

A new political party has emerged nine months ahead of the assembly polls. Precisely, it is a conglomeration of various political and non political parties in Kokrajhar. Named [as](#) the United People's Party, it is formed under the banner of People's Co-ordination for Democratic Rights (PCDR).

Former Rajya Sabha MP and ex-president of All Bodo Students Union (ABSU) Urkhao Gwra Brahma is the president while ex-BTC MCLA Pradip Kumar Damary is the general secretary of the new party which was announced at Dotma in Kokrajhar at a special convention of People's Co-ordination for Democratic Rights (PCDR), a conglomeration of various political and non political parties in the BTAD.

The PCDR hold its special convention at Dotma in Kokrajhar where an unanimously resolution was adopted in the delegate session for floating the new political party.

Rwngwra [Narzary](#), [chief](#) coordinator of PCDR said the new party was formed uniting the two regional political party the Bodoland Peoples' Progressive Front (BPPF) and United Democratic People's Front (UDLF) and the PCDR members.

He said that the PCDR will continues its coordination maong various commuity and organisation in the region and will have its new committee within short span of days.

He has eyed newly floated party will fulfill peoples' aspiration and issues of the social integration.

ABSU president Promod Boro said the new party will highlight peoples' related issues and problems in coming days [as](#) society is wanting healthy environment.
