

NIA to probe into missing arms case

IMPHAL, Mar 31 (NENA) Chief Minister Nongthombam Biren has on Saturday said the [National](#) Investigation Agency (NIA) will probe into the missing case of 56 pistols from Arms Kote of 2nd [Manipur](#) Rifles.

“The incident poses a serious threat to both [state](#) and national security,” Biren told a press conference at CM Secretariat.

The [Manipur](#) Chief Minister said the missing case of weapons from Arms Kote of 2nd MR is a matter of serious concern and expressed suspicion that there are political conspiracies in the case.

“The government has already written to the NIA to carry out a thorough investigation into the case. The missing of weapons is a case of treachery,” he said.

The [state](#) cabinet in a meeting yesterday decided to hand [over](#) the case to the investigating agency, CM Biren informed.

Biren said that the arms were brought in to the [state](#) in September 2014. An FIR was filed at [Imphal](#) Police Station after Commanding Officer of 2nd MR registered a case regarding the incident.

He also informed that 5 persons, including 2 personnel of 2nd MR, have been arrested [over](#) the incident.

Cabinet Ministers, BJP MLAs, police and civil officials were present at the press conference.
