

No ambition for CM: Ajmal



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Guwahati: Breaking his silence over the alliance with Congress to beat BJP in 2021 assembly polls, AIUDF president Badaruddin Ajmal denied any ambition for the Chief Minister's job.

Talking to a vernacular daily, Ajmal said that he has little hurdle to become Chief Minister but in the same breath he said that they have not formed the party to become CM. He made the statement at a time when BJP and its allies have been circulating the speculations of Ajmal's aim to take rein of the state.

Congress leader, however, have said that if the grand alliance gets majority, the Chief Minister would be from their party only.

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
