

No bail for ACS-APS officers in jail



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GUWAHATI: The Gauhati High Court declined bail to 19 civil and police officers who were arrested in connection with the APSC scam.

A High Court bench which reserved the ruling last week on Monday cleared the ruling.

The same bench rejected the anticipatory bail [petition](#) moved by Nishamoni Deka who has been absconding since the police [launched](#) the massive crackdown against the accused ACS, APS officers.

She moved the Supreme Court seeking anticipatory bail which rejected it and she then moved the High Court.

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
