

No end of our road: GNLA



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SHILLONG: [GNLA](#) vows to carry forward its struggle for the cause of the Garo people in [Meghalaya](#) setting at rest the speculation of an end of the road for the dreaded rebel outfit in the north eastern [state](#).

In a statement issued two days after the elimination of the rebel head Sohan D Shira, the rebels remained firm on their own identity, ideologies.
