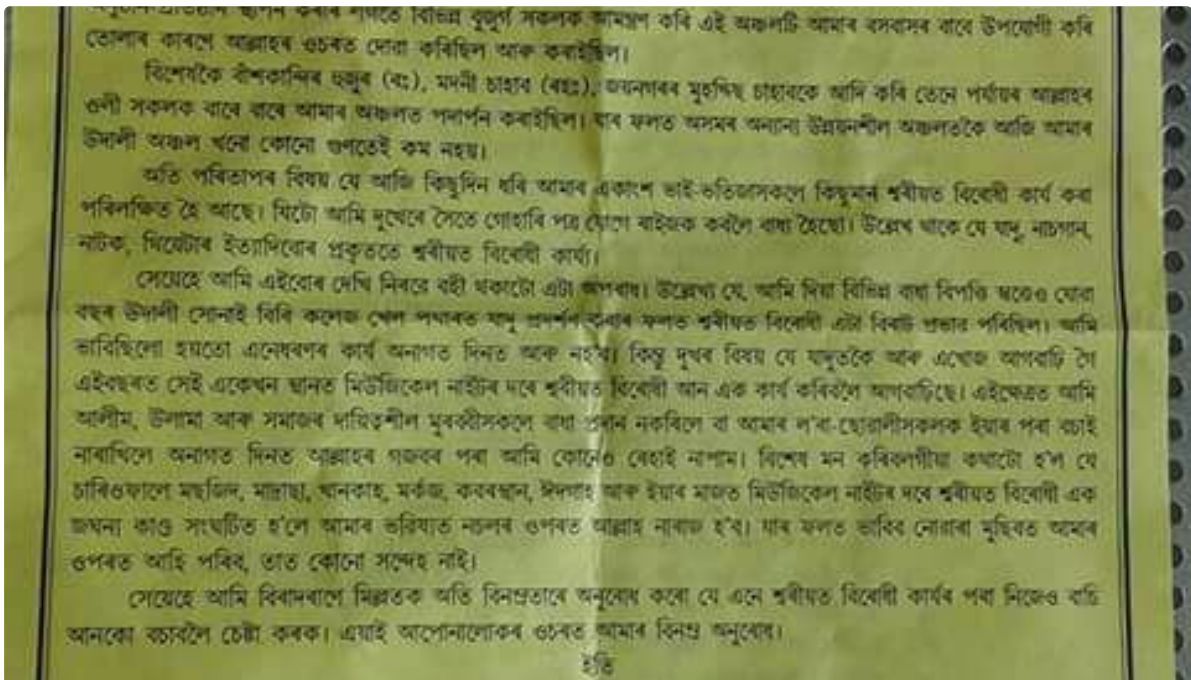


No fatwa against Nahid
