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After weeks of will-it-won't-it, the Assam government restricts sale of [maggi](#) from Thursday. The decision was finalized hours after the experts [found](#) the substance of [lead](#) and MSG in the Nestle product.

[Health](#) minister Dr Nazrul Islam who received the report from the laboratory has finally asked the authority to restrict sale and purchase of [maggi](#). On Wednesday the [health](#) department collected the [maggi](#) samples and conducted test at the laboratory where the inadmissible substances surfaced.
