

No movement on NH No 37!



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The current flood wave in [Kaziranga](#) is likely to force the authority to suspend the movement of traffic on the [National](#) Highway No 37.

According to information, a huge portion of the vital road in the [state](#) has come under the surging [waters](#) of the [Brahmaputra](#) causing immense misery for the birds and wild animals.

Herds of wild elephants are waiting to shift to the nearby karbi hills. A number of rhinos in the national park have already crossed the road while some others have not been able to do it because of the flood [waters](#). Many deer and buffalos have been reeling under the flood [waters](#).

The forest [guards](#) have [rescued](#) a rhino calf from the flood [waters](#). The hapless [animal](#) has been sent to the rehabilitation camp for treatment.





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
