

NRC move: AASU lambasts Gogoi



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The All [Assam](#) Students Union (AASU) continues to target [Tarun Gogoi](#) two days after the [chief](#) minister decided to move the Centre for inclusion in NRC those whose name figure in voter list by virtue of [birth](#).
