

ONGC explosives in Sonai blast!



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Security forces are examining the Sonai explosions from several angles a day after a [10](#) year old boy was left injured. Police officials are tightlipped on the findings so far. But they denied a jihadi link to the explosions. Police however, have not made any [arrest](#) so far.

According Assam Times Crime Research Bureau, the explosives used in Sonai blast were believed have been brought from ONGC sites forcing the police officials to visit the ONGC where a section of the officials were questioned.

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
