The Ministry of [Home](#) Affairs [launched](#) an Online Reporting Portal: www.cybercrime.gov.in accepting complaints of Child Pornography and Rape/Gang Rape (CPRGR) contents being circulated through internet.

The portal is an initiative of Government of [India](#) under [National](#) Mission for the safety of women by utilising Nirbhaya funds, to facilitate [victims](#)/complainants to report cybercrime complaints online. At present this portal caters to complaints pertaining to online Child Pornography (CP)/ Child Sexual Abuse Material (CSAM) or sexually explicit content such as Rape/Gang Rape (CP/RGR) content.

Complaints reported on this portal are dealt by respective police authorities of States/ UTs based on the information in the complaints provided by the complainants.

Option for anonymous reporting of CP/RGR content has been provided on this portal as per the direction of Hon'ble Supreme Court under the matter of Suo Motu Writ Petition no.3/2015.
