

Online Fraud on the Rise in Nazira Revenue Circle; Common People Targeted



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The Nazira Revenue Circle is witnessing a surge in online scams, with innocent people being targeted by fraudsters. The scammers are misusing the online system introduced by the state government for land-related services, exploiting citizens and causing significant financial losses.

Recently, several applicants received phone calls from unknown numbers, asking for sensitive personal information and demanding money under the pretext of facilitating land-related work. The fraudsters are using the names of the Sivasagar and Nazira Revenue Circles to lure applicants.

The Nazira Circle Officer, Chandana Baruah, confirmed that a complaint has been lodged with the police and acknowledged the possibility of an insider's involvement. A public notice has been issued, cautioning citizens against sharing personal information.
