The United Liberation Front of Asom is likely to clear its stand on the peace process with the government even as the Centre is clearing the decks to get jailed ULFA leader Anup Chetia get extradited. Top sources of the banned insurgent outfit said the jailed ULFA leaders are likely to announce the decision.

The announcement would be significant hardly a week after ULFA Commander in Chief Paresh Baruah vowed massive strike on security forces deployed in Assam. In yet another development, India is all set to strike an extradition deal with Bangladesh on Tuesday to get ULFA topgun Anup Chetia deported.
