

PM to visit Assam on ULFA Foundation Day

Prime minister Dr Manmohan Singh will visit Assam on April 7 to campaign for the party four days before the final phase of assembly polls slated for April 11. Talking to assamtimes, senior APCC leaders said on Sunday that Dr Singh is scheduled to attend a series of poll rallies. The Ulfa would also observe their foundation day forcing the authorities to go for a massive security arrangement on that day.
