

Poaching clues unearthed



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Yet another vital clue on rampant rhino poaching in [Kaziranga](#) surfaces when police interrogated three poachers after being captured in Jorhat on Wednesday.

Policemen tracing the development told Assam Times that some sensational revelations have come to light in the confessional statements of the poachers who were caught following an encounter with forest guards where a poacher was killed.

Forest guards claimed to have recovered two rhino horns from their possession. Interrogation is going on to extract more revelations.

The encounter took place in the wee hours when forest guards came to see three poachers in Burapahar range were searching near the [National](#) Highway 37.

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
