

Police grill arrested APSC member

Police on Wednesday arrested APSC member Assam Samedur Rahman on corruption charges.

The special investigation team set up to probe the allegations of corruption [caught](#) Rahman from Rangia early in the morning a week after they arrested chairman Rakesh [Paul](#).

Then the APSC member who was believed to have been hiding in Baksa district was brought in Guwahati where he is being interrogated at the 4th Assam Police Battalion (APBN) in Kahilipara.

Rahman was [caught](#) acting on the statements of his personal security officer Mabud Ali Choudhury.

The entire case came to light when police took up a complaint filed by a dental surgeon revealing that he had promised to give her a [job](#) through the APSC for a bribe of Rs [10](#) lakh.

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NAZIRA, September 27, 2026 — Tension continues to prevail in Nazira, particularly in the Santak-Bihubar area, following the killing of Biman Barua, president of the Rangajan Yuva Samaj and a youth social worker, on September 18 under Bihubar Police Station.

Following the killing, local residents have been demanding stringent punishment for the alleged masterminds, Ravindra Singh alias Vicky Singh and Rubul Khan, besides seeking demolition of Vicky Singh's residence.

Meanwhile, Sivasagar district police have taken Vicky Singh and Rubul Khan into custody and are questioning them at the district headquarters police station in connection with the murder case and allegations of drug-related activities.

According to police sources, the two allegedly told investigators during questioning that drugs were brought from Dimapur and Nagaland and stored at the residence of Vicky Singh's sister in Nazira town. The drugs were allegedly supplied from the house to users in different parts of Nazira and Sivasagar.

Based on the information allegedly obtained during the questioning, a joint team of Bihubar Police and Nazira Model Police Station conducted a raid at the residence of Vicky Singh's sister, Rinki Singh Bora, in Ward No. 6 of Nazira town on Saturday morning.

Police detained Rinki Singh Bora and are reportedly questioning her in connection with the alleged storage and distribution of drugs.

The investigation into the murder of Biman Barua and the alleged drug network is continuing.
