

Police interrogating Soobodh



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The Dhemaji police team set up to probe the Silapothar arson early this month has been interrogating Soobodh Biswas a day after the main accused was [caught](#) in West Bengal on Wednesday.

Police officials are tightlipped on the revelations but the physician turn social activists for the Hindu Bangla-speaking people is believed to have invited the clash where a section of the protestors ransacked a local AASU office triggering statewide protest.

But the investigators would ascertain the charges [against](#) him after corroborating with the statements of 45 other people now under police custody.

Biswas, whom, police kept at a police guest house after tbd arrival on Wednesday would be flown to Dhemaji to be produced before a local court in a day or two.

On the other hand, AASU along with many other organizations have been staging demonstrations demanding exemplary punishment of Biswas and his associates.
