

Policeman killed in militant attack



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Terror shadow seems to have fallen in Assam in the run up to the Independence Day slated for Monday. A policemen killed and another sustained serious injury when suspected KPLT rebels attacked a police station in Karbi Anglong district on Saturday.

The incident took place in the wee hours where a [group](#) of rebel started an indiscriminate firing at Rongbongway police station where two policemen were left injured. [One](#) of them died on the way to the hospital while another is struggling with death at a hospital.

Security forces have been carrying out an intensified operation in search of the KPLT rebels who attacked the policed station two days before the Independence Day.

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
