

Poll-related violence at Dimakuchi

Sensation has been prevailing in [Udalguri](#) district following the cold blooded murder of a tea garden labour. [One](#) Ravi Baiga(35) of Suwala Tea estate died after he was attacked with Dao by miscreants. Another Kaliga Gour (45) has survived the attack. The incident occurred on the night of Monday last. A team of police led by SDPO [Bhergaon](#) Pranjali [Bora](#) immediately rushed the spot and took stock of the situation. Following the incident on Tuesday more than two hundred tea garden labours took to streets shouting slogans 'Hagrama Mahillary Go back' , 'Stop atrocities on Adivadis" etc;

[Adivasi student](#) bodies have condemned the killings and termed the incident [as](#) political killings. And threatened of dire consequences if such atrocities on innocent tea tribe people takes place near future. It is also learned that both the persons were supporters of an Independent candidate contesting election from Panery LAC.

NAZIRA, September 27, 2026 — Tension continues to prevail in Nazira, particularly in the Santak-Bihubar area, following the killing of Biman Barua, president of the Rangajan Yuva Samaj and a youth social worker, on September 18 under Bihubar Police Station.

Following the killing, local residents have been demanding stringent punishment for the alleged masterminds, Ravindra Singh alias Vicky Singh and Rubul Khan, besides seeking demolition of Vicky Singh's residence.

Meanwhile, Sivasagar district police have taken Vicky Singh and Rubul Khan into custody and are questioning them at the district headquarters police station in connection with the murder case and allegations of drug-related activities.

According to police sources, the two allegedly told investigators during questioning that drugs were brought from Dimapur and Nagaland and stored at the residence of Vicky Singh's sister in Nazira town. The drugs were allegedly supplied from the house to users in different parts of Nazira and Sivasagar.

Based on the information allegedly obtained during the questioning, a joint team of Bihubar Police and Nazira Model Police Station conducted a raid at the residence of Vicky Singh's sister, Rinki Singh Bora, in Ward No. 6 of Nazira town on Saturday morning.

Police detained Rinki Singh Bora and are reportedly questioning her in connection with the alleged storage and distribution of drugs.

The investigation into the murder of Biman Barua and the alleged drug network is continuing.
