

Powerful IED recovered in Sonari

Security forces recovered a huge IED in Sonari bordering Nagaland on Thursday. The powerful IED was recovered in the morning at Teokhabi village which was kept beneath the ground at the backyard of the resident Tankeswar Kurmi. The IED was believed to have been planted by ULFA's Paresh Baruah faction which was seized during a search operation by Army's 299 Field Regiment. Later it was defused by army's bomb squad.
