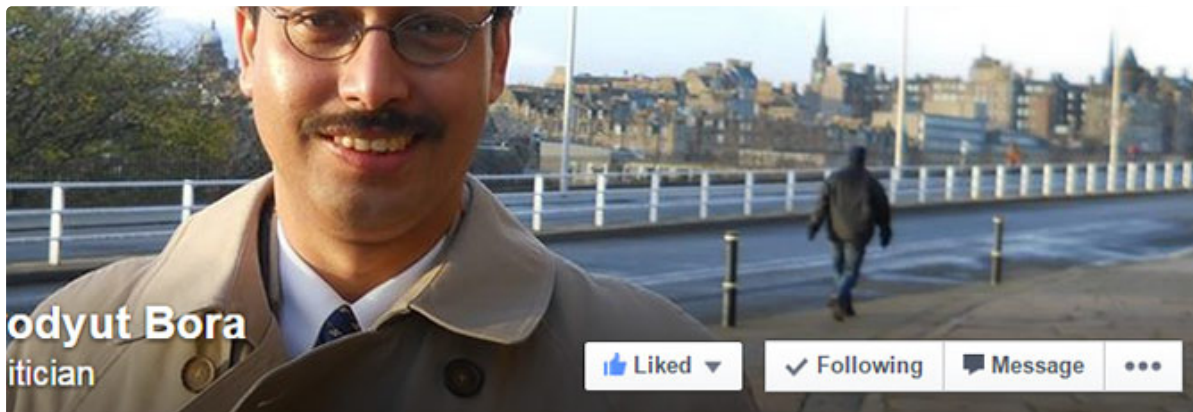


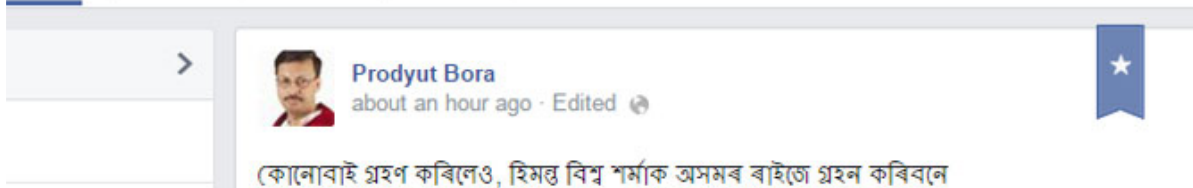
Pradyut ups ante on Himanta



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Amid flutter in political landscape following Dr Himanta Biswa Sarma's move to join BJP, Pradyut [Bora](#) sharpens attack on the former minister.

In his post in a social networking site on Wednesday, the BJP national executive member has outlined a number of reasons opposing Dr Sarma's entry in BJP.

[Bora](#) charged the former minister with helping late Hiteswar Saikia rush the spine of the Assam Agitation. Moreover, he said that Dr Sarma did precious little to implement the Assam Accord when he held the portfolio from 2011 to 14.
