

Presidential Elections: Patil wins by more than 3 lakhs vote

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India got its first woman President. Pratibha Patil won the Presidential elctions by 3,06,810 votes. Pratibha Patil, the UPA candidate defeated her rival Bhairon Singh Shekhawat who was backed by the NDA. There was some cross voting by BJP dissidents in Gujrat and Madhya Pradesh.

Bhairon Shingh Shekhawat has resigned from the position of Vice President as well

In Assam, Pratibha Patil has secured 92 votes while Shekhawat has secured 20 votes.
