

Protest in Tinsukia over Nagalim theory

TINSUKIA: More than 1000 people from five different organizations staged dharna in [Tinsukia](#) on Monday alleging a conspiracy to compromise Assam's territorial integrity in the name of the greater Nagalim.

The [leaders](#) of the five [student](#) and youth organizations who staged demo in front of the Deputy Commissioner's office dared the Centre to make public the peace frame work signed between the NDA government and [NSCN](#)-IM three years back.

Later, they sent s memorandum to Prime Minister through the Deputy Commissioner raising the demand. They further threatened to launch a massive agitation if the Centre compromises Assam's territorial integrity.

Chatra Mukti Sangram Samity, [AJYCP](#), All Assam Gorkha Students Union, Asom Sangrami Oikya Manch, Sangrami Yuva Chatra Parishad took out the demonstration.
