

Protested Swami in Kokrajhar

Protest wave continued in Assam [against](#) BJP [leader](#) and Member of [Parliament](#) Dr Subramaniam Swami's remarks on mixed of religion and politics while visiting to the state that Kokrajhar district committee of All Assam Minority Students Union([AAMSU](#)) and All BTC Minority Students Union(ABMSU) protested and burnt effigy of Dr Swami.

Rafikul Islam, [AAMSU leader](#) strongly reacted Swami's remarks on religion as India represents secular in its status. He said that BJP [leader](#) Swami was trying to create to communal resented in the state, for which why he is making irrelevant remarks. He said that they ([AAMSU](#)) would not allow Swami to make any communal comments. The [AAMSU](#) further asked the government not to allow the BJP [leader](#) to visit the state and his stepping to Assam should be banned.
