

Protesters flogged in Baksa

Several people sustained injury when policemen sprang upon them for taking out a [procession](#) in [Baksa](#) district violating [curfew](#) on [Thursday](#) in [protest](#) against the brutal [killing](#) of a student leader.

The incident took place in Musolpur where policemen flogged a group of people apart from bursting tear gas shells to disperse a [mob](#) as they were taking out a [procession](#) defying [curfew](#) with the [body](#) of a student leader shot [dead](#) by unidentified gunmen in Musalpur area of [Baksa](#) district on [Wednesday](#) night. a section of the local residents forcibly tried to take out the [procession](#) resulting in the bursting of tear gas shells and lathicharge to quell the irate [mob](#).

Identified as Manoj Das, the student leader and an activist of the Sanmilita Janogosthioa Oikya [Manch](#), was shot at by two motorcycle borne gunmen near Musalpur [police](#) station as he was returning home.

He succumbed to his injuries on way to the Gauhati Medical [College](#) Hospital.

He was involved with the campaigning for former [ULFA](#) leader and Independent candidate Naba Kumar [Saranía](#) (Hira) supported by the [Manch](#) in the Lok [Sabha polls](#) this year. According to allegations, he had received [death](#) threats. But [police](#) did not act on the [FIR](#).
