

Protesters hurt in Guwahati police lathicharge



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Several people including a journalist sustained injury when dsecurity forces sprang upon a [group](#) of people as the tried to disrupt an eviction drive at a reserved forest in the outskirt of Guwahati on Monday.

The incident took place in the morning when the eviction hit tribal people in the Amchang reserved forest prevented the forest and district administration officials from proceeding to the forest area to supervise the drive.

Then police and CRPF jawans deployed resorted to [lathi](#) charge and tear [gas](#) shellsto disperse these protesters.

A huge contingent of security forces are moving in the entire sensitive area to ensure smooth eevection drive against the unauthorized settlers which will continue for the next three days.

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
