

Prove charges or face the music: AGP to Himanta



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Stunned by the cash deal allegations, a stunned Asom Gana Parishad asked Assam health minister Dr Himanta Biswa Sarma to produce evidence with video footage within 24 hours.

Addressing a press conference in Guwahati on Tuesday, AGP spokesman Atul Bora said what Dr Sarma has said is totally baseless. Bora further said the party would take Dr Sarma to the court if he fails to prove his charges of cash transaction.

According to Bora, Dr Sarma was trying his best to create a string of pre-poll violence so that the party could extract political mileage from the troubled waters. The AGP leader countered the charges of AGP's negligence for the minorities and women in the list of candidates saying the regional party does not have any politics based on castes, creeds and religion.

Notably, Dr Sarma was trying to make a kind of flutter on Monday saying that a huge amount of cash deal only ensured pre-poll alliance between AGP and BJP and that he has evidence in video footage to prove his charges.
