

Public ground “Gandhi Bakari” inaugurated



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Long pending demand for a public play ground has at last been fulfilled here at Kalaigaon with the inauguration of the “Gandhi Bakari” near circle office, Kalaigaon. Nonagenarian freedom fighter and social worker Pani Ram Das formally inaugurated it on April 25. It is worth mentioning that people of Kalaigaon had been facing the crisis of a public meeting place which could also be used for sports and cultural activities. Fortunately, D.N. Hazarika, the outgoing circle officer of Kalaigaon revenue circle had reserved the said plot of land measuring five bighas for public use and accordingly decided to name the plot as “Gandhi Bakari”, as a token of respect to the father of the nation. Inaugurating “Gandhi Bakari”, freedom fighter Pnai Ram Das thanked DN Hazarika for his noble plan. In his emotional speech the freedom fighter remembered days during their non violent struggle against British.
