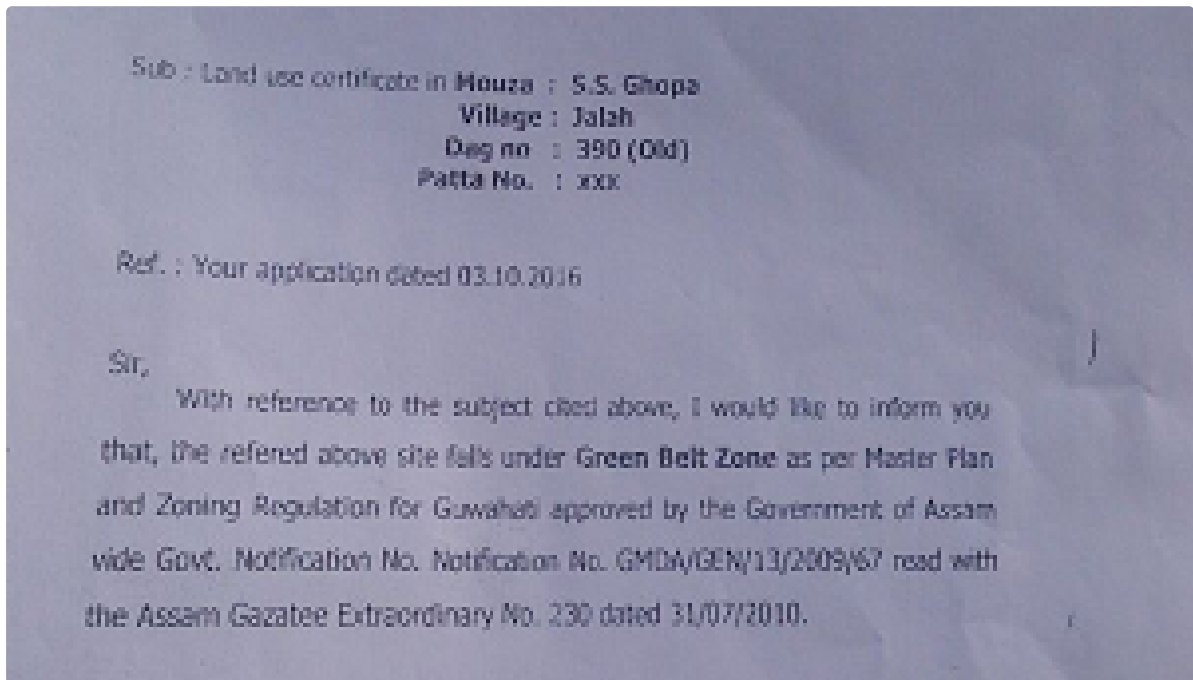


Raha revives AIIMS hopes
