

Rahul drops bombshell: Confirms Gogoi allegation



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[Congress](#) vice president Rahul [Gandhi](#) dropped a huge bombshell [against](#) RSS on Monday revealing that the religious [group](#) attached to BJP prevented him from visiting a historic Vaishnavite place in Assam.

Talking to reporters on way to the [Parliament](#) Bhawan, [Gandhi](#) said RSS deployed some women to stopped from visiting the Barpeta Satra after I wrapped up my padyatra.
