

Rail Blockade called off

Demanding immediate resumption of 'Hill Queen Express', several organizations of Maibang like Youth Council for Development, Dishru Cultural Club, J. B. Hagjer Club, Dimasa Women Society, Maibang Sports Association etc and people from Kalachand organized 100 hours Rail Blockade from 6 AM of February 25 at Maibang Railway station.

They had earlier on February 7 submitted a memorandum to the Divisional Railway Manager, Lumding for the restoration of the 'Hills Queen Express' running in between Lumding - Lower Haflong. As the DRM, NR Railway did not respond to their memorandum, they have decided to go for 100 hours Rail Blockade.
