

Rail blockade in Raha

Movement of all trains came to a grinding halt on Thursday when local residents in large number blocked the [rails](#) in Raha demanding the proposed AIIMS in central part of the state.

Raising slogans demanding an immediate shift in the AIIMS venue, the protesters squatted on the rail tracks at [8](#) in the morning forcing several trains to [stop](#) for three hours.

Later the blockade was called off with a warning that it would resume if the demand fails to reach the authorities.
