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A one hour long heavy downfall wreaks havoc in Guwahati with massive waterlogging disrupting [normal](#) life in many areas on Friday.

The heavy downfall began at 5 in the evening which lasted till [7](#) in the evening leaving many place to be submerged in rain waters.
