

Rajnath Singh effigy burnt in Nazira



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Hundreds of activists from the Bihottar Asomiya Youva Mancha in Nazira burnt the effigy of Union home minister Rajnath Singh alleging his failure to curb the incidents of [racial](#) attacks on the north east students in other parts of the country.

Talking to Assam Times, the protestors said that the Centre must step in to rein in the goons who have been repeatedly launching attacks on the north east people.

“We demand immediate [arrest](#) of the goons involved in these incidents and exemplary punishments,” said the protesters who shouted slogans alleging the Centre’s failure.
