

Rakesh Paul to move SC with bail plea

GUWAHATI: Amid the crucial probe into the APSC scam, the Gauhati High Court on Tuesday rejected the bail [petition](#) moved by chairman Rakesh [Paul](#) who has been languishing in jail for the last several months.

A disappointed [Paul](#) and his legal team now has no option to pin hopes on the Supreme Court for respite. His lawyers, sources, say are moving the apex court challenging the ruling on Tuesday.

A division bench of the court ruled that since the probe into the nefarious cash for [job](#) scam has reached a crucial stage, the bail is not advisable for the chairman.

[Paul](#) who two months back procured bail from the Supreme Court was rearrested acting on a fresh bribery case registered against him in Bhangagarh police outpost.

Sources told Assam Times that [Paul](#) is moving the country's apex court challenging the High Court's ruling on Tuesday.
